¹ CIBC Rewards Program clients may "transfer," which means move, the Aventura points earned from eligible Aventura credit card accounts, where they are the Primary Cardholder or Rewards Officer. Transferring Points can be done between Aventura credit cards through cibcrewards.com or by calling the CIBC Rewards Centre at 1888 232-5656. Authorized Users and Delegates cannot perform points transfer transactions, but will be able to view any points transfer activity on the Primary Cardholder's account in their account history. Points entered must be positive and within the minimum of 1 and the maximum of total points available in the account, at the time of performing points transfers. The Credit Card Accounts that you wish to transfer points between must be in good standing.
